Day 1: Toronto → Cairo

Overnight flight departs from Toronto to Cairo, the capital city of Egypt.

Day 2: Cairo -Sakkara Step Pyramid - Alexandria (Lunch, Dinner)

Upon arrival in Cairo, the tour begins with Step Pyramid, and is an archaeological site in the Saqqara necropolis, Egypt, northwest of the ruins of Memphis. It is the first pyramid to be built. The 6-tier, 4-sided structure is the earliest colossal stone building in Egypt. After lunch, we'll move on to visit Alexandria, the 2nd largest city and a Mediterranean port city in Egypt. During the Hellenistic period, it was home to a lighthouse ranking among the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World as well as a storied library. After dinner, check into 5* Hilton Cornich Resort or same class.

Day 3: Alexandria (Lighthouse Ruins & Citadel of Qaitbay, Pompey's Pillar, Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa) - Cairo (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast in the hotel, visit the 15th-century Citadel of Qaitbay, which was built on the ruins and foundations of the Pharaoh's Lighthouse. Among them, the Pompeii Column erected in the ruins of the Sicraban Temple is 30 meters high and made of red granite. It is the most famous relic in the castle. The underground tomb not far from Pompeii's Column is a multi-level maze with a huge spiral staircase at the entrance. There are more than ten tombs filled with statues and murals, showing religious symbols that mix Roman, Greek and Egyptian characteristics. Return to Cairo after tour. Overnight at the 5* Hilton Golf Hotel or same class

Day 4: Cairo (Giza Pyramid, Sphinx, Monument of Unknown Soldier Memorial, Sadat Tomb) → Aswan

After breakfast in the hotel, visit one of the Seven Wonders of the World, a world cultural heritage, the Giza Pyramid and the Sphinx. It has a history of 4,500 years and is the tomb of the ancient Egyptian pharaoh. It took 100,000 people and 2.3 million huge stones to build it. , the scale of the 20-year project is unprecedented and unprecedented. You can ride a camel in the Sahara Desert. In the afternoon, visit the tomb of former President Sadat and the Monument to the Unknown Soldier. After the trip, go to the airport and fly directly to the famous southern city of Aswan. Accommodation at the 5* Tolip Hotel in Aswan or same class

Day 5: Aswan - Optional Tour to Abu Simbel (UNESCO) (Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast in the hotel, either free time in the morning or you can also visit the Abu Simbel Temple at your own expense. It is known as the most unique and historically valuable temple in Egypt. Standing on the cliffs of the Nile River, it was built by Pharaoh Ramses II in 1275 BC. The building itself and the statues inside are well preserved. Accommodation at the 5* Tolip Hotel in Aswan or same class

Day 6 : Aswan (High Dam, Unfinished Obelisk, Felucca Ride) - Nile Cruise - Kom Ombo(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast in the hotel, visit the Aswan Dam, a majestic appearance and a huge project that attracts world attention. After lunch; proceed to see the unfinished obelisk left by ancient Egyptian. Then take an ancient sailing boat cruise Felucca ride along the Nile River, you can see the Mausoleum of the Muslim leader Aga Khan. After dinner, Accommodation Nile River 5* Cruise for 3 nights.

Day 7 : Edfu Temple (Temple of Horus) - Luxor (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast on the cruise, arrange a horse-drawn carriage ride (2 people per car, fee included) to visit the Temple of Edfu, which is dedicated to Horus, the falcon god who represents justice. It was built starting in 237 BC and took almost three hundred years to complete. Due to this the temple was buried under the sand for many years, making it one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt. Continue to take a cruise to Egypt's 3,500-year-old ancient capital Luxor, where you will have lunch and dinner on the cruise ship. Accommodation Nile River 5* Cruise for 3 nights.

Day 8 : Karnak Temple - Luxor Temple(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast on the cruise, proceed to visit the oldest and largest Karnak Temple. The Pillar Hall has 134 huge stone pillars, each 21 meters high, covering an area of more than 5,000 square meters. It was, at its peak, the largest and most important religious complex in ancient Egypt. Then visit Luxor Temple. There are a row of sphinxes on both sides of the main entrance, is a large Ancient Egyptian temple complex located on the east bank of the Nile River in the city today known as Luxor and was constructed approximately 1400 BCE. In the Egyptian language it was known as ipet resyt, "the southern sanctuary". Lunch and dinner on the boat, Accommodation Nile River 5* Cruise for 3 nights.

Day 9 : Valley of the Kings - Hatshepsut Temple - Colossi of Memnon – Hurghada(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast on the cruise, proceed to the Valley of the Emperors. The famous tomb of Pharaoh Tutankhamun was discovered in 1922. More than 60 pharaoh tombs have been discovered. The Queen's Palace is built for the female pharaoh Hatshepsut 3,500 years ago, this temple built on the mountain is extraordinary. Two huge stone statues of Amenhotep III, the pharaoh of the 18th Dynasty, a masterpiece of the ancient Egyptians. After lunch, proceed to Hurghada, a resort on the Red Sea in eastern Egypt, which is also a famous water sports resort and diving paradise. Accommodation: 5* Hurghada Marriott Beach Resort Hotel or same class.

Day 10 : Hurghada (Free for Leisure) (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

The day is free for activities. Group members can enjoy the blue sea and blue sky or take a boat out to sea at their own expense, try snorkeling and watch corals and colorful tropical fish. In the evening, you can enjoy the dusk scenery of this seaside town, and a special car is arranged to go to the Grand Market for shopping. At your own expense: charter a Red Sea cruise with lunch, and take a jeep on the sand. Stand among the desert hills and enjoy the moment of sunrise or sunset. Accommodation: 5* Hurghada Marriott Beach Resort Hotel or same class.

Day 11: Hurghada (morning free for leisure) → Cairo(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast in the hotel, we have some free time in the morning. You can enjoy various free facilities in the hotel. After lunch, to avoid the 6-8 hours of long-distance driving, we will take a flight from Hurghada directly to Cairo. After arrival; have dinner, Overnight at the 5* Hilton Golf Hotel or same class

Day 12: Egyptian Museum, Grand Egyptian Museum*, Grand Bazaar → Toronto(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast in the hotel, proceed to visit the famous Egyptian Museum, which contains a large number of cultural relics with a history of more than 3,000 years, such as pharaoh statues and royal treasures carved from pure gold. Products, Tutankhamun's solid gold sarcophagus, mummy exhibition, etc. are eye-opening. After lunch, we go to the newly built Grand Egyptian Museum, which has countless treasures and has been long-awaited by the world. It is the largest archaeological museum in the world. After the museums, go to Cairo Grand Bazaar, where you can buy exquisite souvenirs and taste authentic mint tea or mango juice. You could also watch the ancient Egyptian papyrus paintings and fragrance-making techniques. After dinner, transfer to the airport and take a flight back to Toronto.

Day 13 : Toronto
