Day 1: Toronto → Marseille/ France

Departure from Toronto to Marseille, a port city in southern France. It is located on the coast of the Gulf of Lion, part of the Mediterranean Sea, is the third largest in France after those of Paris and Lyon. Overnight flight

Day 2: Marseille city tour (Dinner)

Upon arrival in Marseille, the tour will begin: The Byzantine style Notre Dame de la Garde Basilica, standing on the highest point of the city overlooking the old port.

Day 3: Lavender Fieldin Provence- Gordes (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 4: Avignon - Arles (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

A legacy of papal rule-Avignon, a place of medieval to Renaissance art and culture. UNESCO World Heritage site of the Saint Benezet Bridge. Arles, a place with the remains in the Roman era and a city which had inspired the famous artist Van Gogh on his paintings.

Day 5: Bridge of Pont du Gard - Carcassonne Castle (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

UNESCO World Heritage monument best preserved, the Pont du Gard, a three level Roman aqueduct. Carcassonne Castle is an outstanding example of a historic medieval fortified French town, and of course, a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Day 6: Arcachon Bay- Dune de Pilat - Bordeaux (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Try the fresh oysters at Arcachon, a seaside resort known for its oyster harvesting. Dune de Pilat, the highest sand dune in Europe in between a breathtaking view of the North Atlantic Ocean and an enormous pine forest. Next stop - Bordeaux.

Day 7: Saint Emilion - Loire Valley (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Both UNESCO World Heritage sites hosting long history between men and grape vines. An experience with Wine tasting and authentic French Cuisine.

Day 8: Chateau de Chenonceau- Chateau de Villandry (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Chateau de Chenonceau, the most visited magnificent chateau inside out and one of the best known in the Loire Valley. Chateau de Villandry, a grand country mansion with its beautiful gardens and maze.

Day 9: Mount Saint Michel (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Mont Saint Michel - a medieval monastery on a magical island. A very stunning sight when invades by the highest tide in Europe.

Day 10: Etretat - Giverny - Paris (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Spectacular shapes of white cliffs carved by nature drew plenty of artists to the picturesque Etretat. Giverny, this village in Normandy once lived the famous impressionist painter Claud Monet, who got his inspiration from his house and beautiful elaborate gardens.
