

GOChina Part II - 4 Provinces 18 Days: Inner Mongolia, NingXia, ShaanXi, ShanXi

(Tour start from and finish at : Beijing)

Departure date: 2026 May26, 28 Aug23 Sep 02, 04, 08

Day 1: Beijing Airport pick up service

Free pick up from Beijing international airport(code PEK) from 12noon till 3pm. Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class

Day 2: Beijing - Hohhot (Grassland High Speed Railway) - City Tour (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

【Grassland High Speed Railway】Take high-speed railway from Beijing to Hohhot for about 2 hours and 30 minutes. Admire the scenic scenery of the Inner Mongolia prairie.

【 Hohhot】Arrive in Hohhot, enjoy the city tour includes Saishang Old Street, Intangible Cultural Heritage . Dazhao Temple, also known as Wuliang Si (Infinite Temple) in Mandarin, is a Buddhist monastery built in 1579. Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class.

Day 3: Hohhot - Xiangsha Bay (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[Sounding Sand Bay] People often say that "Erdos people are good at singing and dancing", and even the sands can sing. Spend the whole day in mysterious Sounding Sand Bay, where you can watch the sunset, listen to sands singing, ride a camel, enjoy the starry sky to find the Milky Way and have a bonfire party in the desert.

Overnight at the Special Hotel.

Day 4 :Xiangsha Bay - Mausoleum of Genghis Khan - Ordos (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[Genghis Khan Mausoleum] According to historical records, the camel hair that absorbs Genghis Khan's last breath—that is, the soul, has been stored in Genghis Khan Mausoleum for hundreds of years.

[Ordos] Admire the desert sunrise. Then visit the well-known China's No. 1 Aobao- Ike Aobao, which was decorating with Mongolian traditional patterns.

Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class.

Day 5: Ordos - Ordos Grassland - Yurt (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[Ordos Grassland] Enjoy the day in Ordos Grassland - Inner Mongolia. Fill your time with Horse riding, taking traditional Mongolian wedding, having Mongolian version of Manchu Banquet: the Fraudulent horse banquet & Roasted lamb. Take leisure of lying on the grassland and watching the stars of the Milky Way.

Overnight at Yurt Hotel

Day 6 : Yinchuan - Rock Paintings of Helan Mountain / Western Xia mausoleums (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[Western Xia mausoleums] At the foot of Helan Mountains, in northwest China's Ningxia Hui Autonomous Region, the mausoleums of ancient Xixia (Western Xia) Kingdom (1038-1227) are known as the "Oriental Pyramid", it was the glorious Western Xia Dynasty. It is one of the largest and most complete imperial cemeteries in China. [Helan Mountain Rock Paintings] The history books on the stone span seven thousand years of history. It is known as the "Art Gallery of Prehistoric Man" in the international petroglyph circle with nearly 6,000 petroglyphs. Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class.



Day 7: Tengger Desert Day Tour - Yinchuan (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[Tengger Desert] Tengger Desert, the fourth largest desert in China. Take an off-road vehicle to visit beautiful scenery such as Swan Lake. There are more than 500 oases, more than 400 lakes, and 251 clear water lakes in the entire desert. You will see many oases, lakes, wild animals and plants. What a pleasant scenery!

Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class.

Day 8: 108 Pagoda - Qingtong Gorge - Jingbian (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[One Hundred and Eight Pagodas] It is a rare large pagoda array in the world, built in the Xixia period with a group of Lama-style solid pagodas.

[Qingtong Gorge] Tour Qingtong Gorge by boat. It has a long history and culture, and the natural scenery is even more beautiful. Transfer to Jingbian this afternoon.

Overnight at the 4*Hotel or same class.

Day 9: Wave Valley - Yan'An (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[Wave Valley] It is full of Danxia landform, and also known as "Chinese Antelope Valley". The wonderful spot was carved by wind and water within millions of years. The layers of red sandstone, just like the "texture of time". Being in it is like entering a magical world, and the magical creation of nature is breathtaking. (This attraction is a new scenic spot.) Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class.

Day 10: Xi'an (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[Xi'an] In the ancient city Xi'an, you can't miss the largest and best-preserved existing Xi'an Ancient City Wall in China. In addition to a leisurely walk on the wall, you can also rent a bike to ride on the wall, half circle or one circle according to your physical strength. Later tour The Big Wild Goose Pagoda and have some free time in Shuyuanmen Culture Street Night Market.

[Dumpling Feast] The most distinctive food in Xi'an- Dumplings, which is constantly innovating in tradition. You can find each dumpling not only has a different shape, but also has its own characteristics in taste. Enjoy the special dinner. Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class.

Day 11: Xi'an-The Terracotta Army - Yunqiu Mountain (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[The Terracotta Army] Visit the marvelous Terracotta Army Museum, the world's eighth wonder. As a must-see in China, it is a fabulous archaeological treasure. You will be definitely amazed by the great underground army, as well as the horse-draw chariots and weapons.

Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class.

Day 12 : Shanxi Wannian Ice Cave - Hukou Waterfall - Linfen (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[Wannian Ice Cave] It ranks first among the nine ice caves in China, which formed in the Cenozoic Quaternary Ice Age 3 million years ago. That's why people call the name "Wannian Ice Cave".

[Hukou Waterfall] The largest Yellow Waterfall in the world and the second largest waterfall in China. Integrating canyons, loess plateaus, and ancient villages into one, it is famous both at home and abroad for its majestic momentum.

Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class.

Day 13: Guangsheng Temple - Wang Family Courtyard (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[Guangsheng Temple] Built in the Yuan and Ming Dynasties, Guangsheng Buddhist temple is famous for its three wonders: the Feihong Pagoda, the murals of the Yuan Dynasty in the Water Temple, and the hanging sculptures are all rare treasures.

[Wang's Courtyard] It took more than 300 years to build 250,000 square meters larger than the Forbidden City in Beijing. It is called "Shanxi's Forbidden City" and is a model of residential architecture in the Qing Dynasty. Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class.



Day 14: Pingyao Ancient City - Jinci Royal Garden - Taiyuan (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[Pingyao Ancient City] As the World cultural heritage, Pingyao Ancient City owns more than 300 historic sites and nearly 4,000 well-preserved Ming and Qing houses. It is the only ancient city in China completely reserved as it was hundreds of years ago without any modern architecture, but only the narrow street flanking with Chinese shops in old style and the road plated with the original stone.

[Taiyuan Jinci Temple]] Jinci Temple, a classical ancestral hall and garden complex, combines the beauty of southern gardens and the heroism of northern pavilions. It is a model, a classic treasure of history and art! Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class.

Day 15: Wutai Shan - Shanxi (breakfast, lunch, dinner)

[Wutai Shan] It is the first of the four famous Buddhist mountains in China, and also the dojo of Manjusri Bodhisattva. As one of the world cultural heritages, you can visit the famous Buddhist Temples.

Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class.

Day 16: Ying County Wooden Pagoda - Shanxi Hanging Temple - Datong (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[Ying County Wooden Pagoda] Built in 1056 AD, it is the oldest and tallest surviving pure wooden structure pavilion-style building, and it is also a treasure of ancient Chinese architecture.

[Hanging Temple] It has a history of 1500 years. The main building of the temple is supported by 27 wooden beams and was built on the mountainside of Cuifeng Mountain. The building's features can be summarized as "strange, cliff and ingenious". Strange- Looking up Hanging Temple in distance, it seems as an exquisitely carved analyph set in steep bluffs; if you observe it closely, it looks as if it is flying to the sky. It still amazes the viewers for thousands of years.

Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class.

Day 17: Yungang Grottoes - Beijing (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

[Yungang Grottoes] Yungang Grottoes were built against the mountain and extend about one km (0.62 miles) from east to west. Comprising 252 caves and 51,000 statues within a carved area of 18,000 square meters, Yungang Grottoes represent the outstanding achievement of Buddhist cave art in China during the 5th and 6th centuries. The Five Caves created by Tan Yao, with their strict unity of layout and design, constitute a classical masterpiece of the first peak of Chinese Buddhist art. Yungang Grottoes have played a vitally important role among early Oriental Buddhist grottoes and had a far-reaching impact on Buddhist cave art in China and East Asia. It were added to the World Cultural Heritage List in December 2001.

High-speed Railway from Datong to Beijing.

Overnight at the 5*Hotel or same class.

Day 18: Beijing - Home (Breakfast)

After breakfast, drive to Beijing international airport (code PEK) for your flight home. Free drop-off 2 times (7:00am, 10:30am) at hotel lobby. End 18 days of the unforgettable journey.
