



Egypt, Alexandria Port – Mediterranean, Hurghada – Red Sea 13 Day Tour

Day 1: Toronto Cairo

Take an overnight direct flight with EgyptAir to Cairo, the capital of Egypt.

Day 2: Cairo – Alexandria (Pompey's Pillar, Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa) (Lunch, Dinner)

Upon arrival in Cairo, transfer to Alexandria, Egypt's second-largest city, famed in antiquity as one of the Seven Wonders of the World.

Visit **Citadel of Qaitbay**, built on the site of the ancient Pharos Lighthouse.

See **Pompey's Pillar**, a 30-meter-high red granite column built on the ruins of the Serapeum temple.

Explore the **Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa**, a multi-level subterranean necropolis with Roman, Greek, and Egyptian motifs.

Overnight at the 5-star **Hilton Corniche Resort** or similar, by the Mediterranean Sea.

Day 3: Alexandria City Tour – Cairo Aswan (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Visit the **ruins of the ancient lighthouse**, once one of the tallest manmade structures of the ancient world and a Seven Wonders of the World site. Explore the **Citadel of Qaitbay**, built on its ruins in the 15th century.

After the tour, fly to **Aswan** in southern Egypt.

Overnight at the 5-star **Aswan Tolip Hotel** or similar (2 nights).

Day 4: Aswan – Optional Tour to Abu Simbel Temples (UNESCO) (Breakfast, Dinner)

Free morning or join an optional tour to **Abu Simbel**, one of Egypt's most remarkable temples.

Built by Pharaoh Ramses II in 1275 BC and carved into a cliff near the Nile.

Overnight at **Aswan Tolip Hotel** or similar.

Day 5: Aswan High Dam – Felucca Ride – Nile Cruise – Kom Ombo (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Visit the **Aswan High Dam**, an engineering marvel.

See the **Unfinished Obelisk**, a massive red granite monument left partially carved.

Enjoy a **felucca ride** on the Nile, passing the **Mausoleum of Aga Khan**.

Embark on a luxury **Nile cruise** toward **Kom Ombo**, the ancient gold capital.

Visit **Kom Ombo Temple**, uniquely dedicated to two gods: Horus (falcon-headed) and Sobek (crocodile god). See the **Crocodile Mummies Museum**.

Overnight on a **5-star Nile cruise ship** (3 nights).



Day 6: Edfu (Temple of Horus) – Luxor (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Ride a horse-drawn carriage to visit **Edfu Temple**, dedicated to Horus, the god of justice. Built from 237 BC and took nearly 300 years to complete.

Continue sailing to **Luxor**, Egypt's ancient capital for over 3,500 years.

Meals and overnight on the Nile cruise.

Day 7: Luxor Temple – Karnak Temple (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Visit the **Karnak Temple**, one of Egypt's largest temple complexes with 134 massive 21-meter-high columns in the Great Hypostyle Hall.

Explore the **Luxor Temple**, where the entrance is lined with sphinx statues.

Meals and overnight on the Nile cruise.

Day 8: Valley of the Kings – Hatshepsut Temple – Colossi of Memnon – Hurghada (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Visit the **Valley of the Kings**, where over 60 royal tombs including that of King Tutankhamun were discovered.

Explore the majestic **Temple of Hatshepsut**, built into the cliffs.

See the **Colossi of Memnon**, two massive statues over 20 meters tall.

Transfer to **Hurghada**, a famous **Red Sea resort**.

Overnight at **5-star Hurghada Marriott Beach Resort** or similar (2 nights).

Day 9: Hurghada – Free Day (Red Sea Leisure) (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Free day to enjoy beach activities or join an optional Red Sea cruise with snorkeling and lunch.

Optional **submarine ride** to view coral reefs and tropical fish.

Overnight at **Hurghada Marriott Beach Resort** or similar.

Day 10: Hurghada (Morning Leisure) Cairo (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Enjoy hotel amenities in the morning.

Fly from Hurghada to **Cairo** to avoid a 6–8 hour bus ride.

Dinner and overnight at **5-star Hilton Golf Resort** or similar.

Day 11: Cairo – Giza Pyramids, Sphinx, Sadat Tomb (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Visit the **Giza Pyramids** and **Sphinx**, built over 4,500 years ago using 2.3 million blocks.

Optional camel ride in the **Sahara Desert**.

Visit the **Tomb of President Sadat** and the **Monument to the Unknown Soldier**.

Overnight at **Hilton Golf Resort** or similar.

Day 12: Cairo – Grand Egyptian Museum, Khan el-Khalili Bazaar Toronto (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Ensure sufficient time to explore the **Grand Egyptian Museum**, the world's largest archaeological museum

Explore the **Khan el-Khalili Bazaar** for souvenirs and local drinks like mint tea or mango juice.

Learn about **papyrus painting** and **perfume making**.

Evening flight back to **Toronto**.

Day 13: Toronto

Arrival at Toronto International Airport.



Once in a life experience in touring the whole Egypt.

Include all International & domestic flights (start from Toronto, total 4 tickets)

Take direct flights, instead of long hours bus drive (Cairo to Aswan & Hurghada to Cairo).

Free upgraded to all 5* Hotels and 5* Nile River Cruise, Meals & Taxes.

Tour included : All International and domestic flight tickets, deluxe coach, upgrade to all 5* Hotels and 5* boat cruise, Meals & Taxes. Sightseeing (except optional tour), meals, deluxe coach, local guide and tour leader service.

Not included : Travel & Medical Insurance, Gratuity for the (Tour leader, Local Guides and Drivers) in total of **US\$210**/passenger and Optional tours. Single room supplement: \$1395

Visa: Canadian passport can pay landing visa on arrival. USA, HKSAR and China passports need to apply e-Visa. Since visa requirements change frequently, please contact the corresponding consulate; our company is not responsible if you are unable to enter the country due to visa or passport issues.

Others: No extra bed provided for children (2-11 years old) if staying with 2 adults in one room. If 3 persons sharing a room, a \$15/person discount can be applied (Due to limited space in cruise ship and only has two single beds. You need to pay an additional \$495 to add a single room on the Nile River cruise). The tour fee already is 3-4 % deducted from the original price. Please pay the original price if using a credit card.

Regulations : Deposit is \$500/person. The balance should be paid off 61 days before departure. The tour itinerary will be adjusted if necessary. If the tour is cancelled, the deposit will be refunded. If a client cancels or makes any change of their itinerary or group air tickets, they must notify 98 days before departure for full refund. If you cancel or make any change to the itinerary or group air tickets within 61-97 days before departure, the group fee of \$500 per person will be deducted. Group air-tickets cannot be canceled within 31-60 days. If the registration is canceled during this period, 50% of the group fee will be deducted. Cancellations within 30 days will be subject to a full deduction and no refund will be given.
