



Sweden, Norway, Finland, Denmark & Iceland 14 Days 5 Countries

Day 1: Toronto → Copenhagen / Denmark

Departure from Toronto to Copenhagen, the capital of Denmark. Overnight flight.

Day 2: Copenhagen Sightseeing (Dinner)

Upon arrival in Copenhagen, the tour will start to visit the The Little Mermaid statue, City center, Danish Royal Palace, waterfront park, Andersen statue etc. Overnight at AC Marriott or same class.

Day 3: Copenhagen – Federick Palace and Garden - DFDS Cruises (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast in the hotel, visit the Federick Palace and Garden. After lunch, then take DFDS cruise to Oslo, the capital of Norway. Overnight at DFDS Cruise.

Day 4: DFDS Cruise - Oslo / Norway - Geilo (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast on the cruise ship, cruise along Norway's unique fjords and arrive in Oslo. Disembark and enjoy a city tour, including the City Hall, the site of the Nobel Peace Prize ceremony, and the Wigner Park with its 212 statues of people sculpted from bronze, iron, and other materials, each with a unique posture. You will also have time to shop for distinctive Nordic souvenirs. Later, drive to Geilo, Norway's famous ski resort town. Overnight at Geilo Veslia hotel or same class.

Day 5: Geilo - Hardanger Fjord - Bergen (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast in the hotel, drive to the waterfall and Hardanger bridge viewpoint. Then drive to Hardenger. It is considered one of the most beautiful areas in Norway. Then we will drive to Bergen, the 2nd largest city of Norway. It is surrounded by mountains and fjords. An optional trip with a great experience on the funicular. The tour starts in the heart of Bergen city centre and takes you to the top in approximately 6 minutes. There you will get a spectacular panoramic view over the city, fjords and mountains. We will visit the most famous Fish Market, one of Norway's most visited outdoors markets. The Fish Market sells seafood, fruits and vegetables. Overnight at Bergen Quality Hotel or same class.

Day 6: Gudvangen - Flam - Sognefjord - Sogndal (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast at the hotel, drive to Gudvangen to take in the panoramic views of the fjord and capture photos. Afterward, proceed to Flåm, the starting point of the fjord railway, to board the [Scenic Train]. Along the route, you will encounter numerous waterfalls, towering cliffs, and other spectacular wonders.

Upon disembarking, drive through the world's longest road tunnel and cross the Sognefjord, the deepest, longest, and largest fjord in the world. Known as the "King of the Fjords," it is a geological marvel left behind by the Ice Age 10,000 years ago; its sheer cliffs and undulating peaks create a magnificent landscape. After crossing the Sognefjord and passing through Sogndal, arrive at Skei, a small town located in the heart of the Norwegian fjords.

After dinner, check in at Thon Hotel or similar for overnight stay.

Day 7: Birkedal Glacier – Cruise on Geiranger Fjord - Geiranger (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast in the hotel, drive to Birkedal Glacier. Taking jeep car close to Glacier and then walk to Glacier. Afterwards we will take one hour cruise on Geiranger Fjord. The deep blue UNESCO-protected GeirangerFjord is surrounded by majestic, snow- covered mountain peaks, wild waterfalls and lush, green vegetation. Drive to Geiranger after. Overnight at Geiranger Hotel or same class.

Day 8: Geiranger – Eidsdal Fjord - Lillehammer (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast in the hotel, drive to Eidsdal Fjord. Visit the famous Ornesvingen eagle road. And also, the famous route Trollstigen road. After lunch, visit Lillehammer, Winter Olympic stadium. Overnight at Scandic Hotel or same class.

Day 9: Lillehammer – Karlstad / Sweden - Stockholm (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast in the hotel, drive to Stockholm, the capital of Sweden. Visit the old city. Overnight at Courtyard Marriott or same class.

Day 10: Stockholm - Viking Cruise – Helsinki / Finland (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast in the hotel, start the city tour, including Old city, City Hall, Warsaw Warship Museum. After lunch, take a Viking Cruise to Helsinki. Overnight at Viking Cruise or Silja Line cruise.

Day 11: Helsinki Sightseeing (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast on the cruise, disembark and start the city tour by bus, including Rock Church, Parliament, Presidential Palace, Olympic Stadium, Sibelius Monument etc. Overnight at Radisson Blu or same class.

Day 12: Helsinki → Reykjavík / Iceland (Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast in the hotel, continue with the city tour and free time at harbor front area. We will stop in front of the most famous landmark of Helsinki, Helsinki Cathedral. We will take a flight to Reykjavik, the capital of Iceland. Upon arrival, visit the famous church – Hallgrímskirkja Church. Then visit "The Sun Voyager" Sculpture. After dinner, overnight at Foss hotel Reykjavik or same class.

Day 13: Golden Circle -Þingvellir National Park, Strokkur Geysir & Gullfoss Waterfall (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast at the hotel, take a private coach to explore Iceland's most famous Golden Circle, which includes Þingvellir National Park, Strokkur Geyser, and Gullfoss Waterfall. Þingvellir National Park is one of Iceland's three UNESCO World Heritage Sites, renowned for its breathtaking landscapes shaped by extraordinary geological forces. The Strokkur Geyser is one of the world's most famous geysers, renowned for its misty landscape and 30-meter-high geyser. Gullfoss is one of Iceland's most beautiful waterfalls. The 70-meter-high, 2500-meter-wide waterfall is named "Golden Falls." After dinner, overnight stay at Foss Hotel or similar.

Day 14: Reykjavik - Blue Lagoon Spa → Toronto (Breakfast)

After breakfast in the hotel, drive to the Blue Lagoon Spa. The Blue Lagoon is one of Iceland's most popular attractions. The beautiful milky-blue water is unlike anything else found on earth and makes a stark contrast to the surrounding black lava fields and creeping grey moss. The water sits at 39°C (102°F) year-round, making it the perfect bathing temperature. That makes it the perfect last stop before leaving the country. Then take the flight back to Toronto.

As visa requirements change frequently, please check local government official information. The company, GOGO TOURS, is not responsible for any failure entry with local customs and immigration due to visa or passport issues.

Others: No extra bed provided for children (2-11 years old) if staying with 2 adults in one room. If 3 people share a room, C\$15 discount for each person can be applied (not guaranteed the third bed could be added). The tour fee already is 3-4% deducted from original price. Please pay the original price if using a credit card.

Regulations: The deposit is \$500/person. The balance should be paid off 90 days before departure. The tour itinerary will be adjusted if necessary. If the tour is cancelled, the deposit will be refunded. If a client cancels or makes any change of their itinerary or group air tickets, they must notify 128 days before departure for full refund. If you cancel or make any change to the itinerary or group air tickets within 91-127 days before departure, the group fee of \$300 per person will be deducted. Group air-tickets cannot be canceled within 61-90 days. If the registration is canceled during this period, 45% of the group fee will be deducted. Cancellations within 31 - 60 days before departure will be subject to a 85% deduction of the total fee. Cancellations within 30 days will be subject to a full deduction and no refund will be given.
